## Delaware RC Club Honors Outstanding Members

At the November/December meeting, the Delaware RC Club recognized a few worthy members of the Club with Lifetime Membership Awards for Outstanding Achievement

**Carl Cantera** was one of three founders of the club in 1956, and has been a member for 50 years. He was president in 1965 and 1968; VP in 1963 and 1964. Carl was an pioneer in the early days of RC modeling and flew in the AMA Nats in 1958, '59, '61, '62, and '63. He has sponsored many improvements and maintenance of the club field and is a major sponsor of Warbirds over Delaware. **Betty Cantera** has been an active supporter of the club and was Secretary for 9 years.

**Graham Lomax** joined the club 49 years ago in 1957 and was Vice President in 1962. He also was an early practitioner of RC and flew in the 1962, '63, '65, and 1976 Nats, where he competed in Expert Pattern. Graham was a member of the AMA Show Team and flew at Oshkosh and at Transpo 72.

**Don Hutchison** joined the club in 1958 and was responsible for the club being AMA chartered and also worked to incorporate the club. He was President in 1962, and has been an active pilot for 48 years.

**Bob Karlsson** has been a member for 37 years, having joined in 1969. He was President in 1972 and ran the club scale contest for many years as a CD. He was AMA district IV Associate VP in 1975 and has been on the AMA Scale Board since 1976. Bob competed in many AMA Nats Precision Scale Contests, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in 1973 and represented USA in the World Scale Contest in Ottawa that year. Bob has competed in Top Gun and Scale Masters; flew on the AMA Show team in Oshkosh and Transpo 72.. His Corsair is on display at the museum in Quantico.

**Scotty Moyer** joined 34 years ago in 1972, and has been Vice President in 2001 and 2002. He was newsletter editor for 6 years and AMA District IV Associate VP for 21 years. He flew on the AMA Show Team at Oshkosh. Scotty demonstrated the functions of RC equipment at mall and museum shows, using a clever mock-up of a simple control system.
