The flood gates have opened on the Spread Spectrum (SS) wave of

radios.

Horizon Hobbies subsidiary, Spektrum, has announced, in addition to their DX-6 Park Flyer and DX-7 Full Range transmitter/ receiver systems, they will be selling modules to fit all existing (modular) JR, Hitec and Futaba radio systems. These modules will transmit 9 channels on JR and 8 on the Hitec /Futaba mode and will come with

Futaba has released a 6 channel radio on spread spectrum and is rumored to have a module in the works also.

There are other parties in the fray: Xtreme Power Systems plans to start selling a modular system for

any radio, access through the trainer port, or certain modules, with up to 16 channels in the middle of April. Nomadio has expressed intention of producing a high-end aircraft radio system and is asking the internet community to suggest design functions. Nomadio is a powerhouse in surface SS radios and is a major supplier to the military.

So; what's this mean to the average RC pilot, and how will this affect our "normal" R/C radios?

Nothing is made obsolete by this new tech**nology**, the presently used radio frequencies will be unaffected by the new radios, there may even be less congestion because of modelers who have switched out of the 72 MHz band.

The advantages of the SS radios include no interference from model generated noise, like ignition, electric motors, long servo leads, etc. In addition, there will be no interference from other models either on the "old" frequencies or on SS band; the spread spectrum requires that they don't interfere with each other.

You will still have to use a frequency pin and place your AMA card in the transmitter impound display. This is for purposes of verifying that all flyers have AMA as well as to assure others that you are on a recognized frequency. Page 2 Glitch Busters

We have been reviewing the club safety rules as they affect the use of the park flying site. One situation stands out that we can do something about quickly and without much effort. Since we made the separation of the Helicopter and Fixed-wing runways it has become convenient to fly on both at once. The intention was to set up so that the two types wouldn't interfere with each other. We need to observe a "no fly zone" at the intersection of the two runways that gives us a 100 foot safety margin between aircraft.

I realize that the evening sun makes it difficult to fly helis to the west, but the chance for a mid-air meeting at the junction of the runways is real. Neither should the fixed wing pilots "cheat the corner" to make an easier approach in a crosswind. Sometime this spring we'll get a marker of some sort out there to remind all of us of the safety zone. Thanks for cooperating, the plane/heli you save may be your own!
