### Field Maintenance


Weed killer will be applied to the field. Field rolling will be scheduled.

## Toledo Show—Big motors, Spread Spectrum, Small planes

The Weak Signals RC Expo, known as the "47 Toledo Show" held its 53rd meeting April 13th to 15th. A few regulars from Delaware RC were I attendance as usual.

While it appeared that attendance was down slightly from previous years, there was no lack of vendor participation.

Notable were the size of electric motors: Hacker had a 15kW motor on display next to their 10kW quad motor. Think of the investment in batteries to run these monsters!

Horizon Hobby was showing the Spektrum line of spread spectrum (SS) radios and modules, including a JR 9303 with SS module directly from JR.

Futaba displayed the six channel SS system and prototype for the 12FG SS system.

Extreme Power Systems was selling their plug-in SS modules to fit any radio with a module or a trainer cord

socket.

Hitec said their modules would be out "soon." (I didn't get to Airtronics)

Chinese imports were everywhere. Beautiful ARFs abounded.

On the competition tables the craftsmanship was overwhelming, as usual. Notable was an aerobatic plane with a Hamilton watch face on the wing and fuselage—no paint—all Monokote!




Joe Malinchak showed his 1/72 scale Hellcat and Keith Shaw had an unusual biplane DFW-T28,
