Message from the Safety Officer

FLYING FIELD SAFETY/RULE REMINDER

- Smoking is not allowed in the pits. Cigarette butts are to be placed in the cans provided and not tossed on the ground in the spectator area or parking lot.
- Children (as spectators) and pets are not allowed in the pit area or flight line.
- Taxiing a model under power (gas or electric) in the pits is not allowed.
- Models with internal combustion engines must be properly restrained while starting.
- Low, high speed fly-bys are to be performed on the far side of the runway, never nearer than the centerline of the runway. It makes no difference how good a pilot is if the airplane is no longer under their control.
