Safety Corner

Frequency Control

Everyone knows that a clothespin from the transmitter impound is needed before you turn on your radio. This is necessary to avoid frequency conflict that could result in "shooting down" someone else's plane.

Equally important is to display that frequency placard on your transmitter antenna. This allows others to see what frequency you are flying on and also verifies to the rest of us that you are complying with the rule.

Some discussion has arisen around "synthesizer" transmitters (frequently called "Dial-A-Crash"). I am not familiar with all of the variants, but I believe that it is difficult, if not impossible to change frequency when the transmitter is broadcasting. When changing frequencies, it's mandatory for safety to double-check the output frequency before it is allowed to transmit, and always have the proper pin for the new frequency
