Holes in prop hubs

Sometimes the hole in the prop isn't big enough to fit on the engine's shaft. The best option to enlarge the hole is to use a prop reamer. A prop reamer centers itself in the existing hole and slowly and cleanly shaves away the sides of the hole. It is best to use a reamer of the proper size but in a pinch you can ream an oversized hole and wrap tape around the engine's shaft to build it up to match the hole in the prop. A third option is to use a drill press. Use a

bit the same diameter as the existing hole to center the prop, secure the prop, then replace the bit with the size you want and carefully drill. To avoid splintering on the exit side of the hole you can drill from the front of the prop, stop before exiting the back side, flip the prop over and finishing the hole. Bear in mind that even a slightly off-center hole will cause excessive vibration. Using a hand drill is not a good option.

Pete M. gave wrap up on war birds.

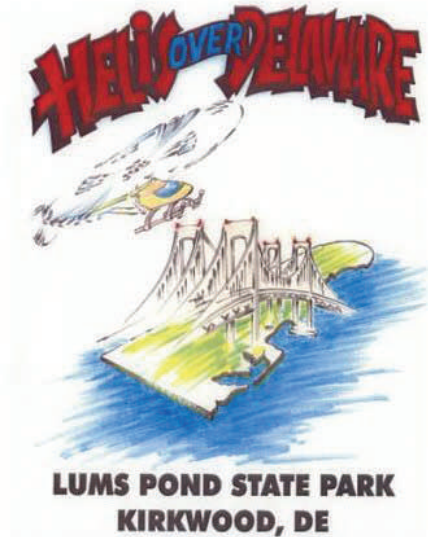
Brian was not present to report on heli event but it was understood that the event went well.

Once the sun went down the fun didn't stop as night flying was enjoyed by all.

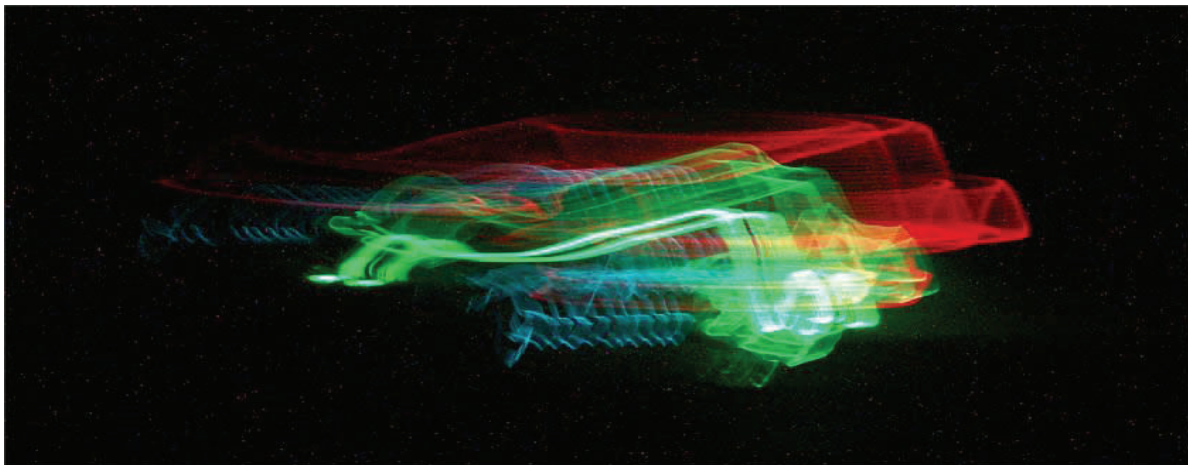

The park will not recognize anything else. And no, it is not okay to fly because it's in the mail or somewhere else. This again happened in August and I do not want to hear that it has happened again in the future. I repeat, "no A.M.A. card means no flying, and no excuses". I hope this is understood by everyone. If a non-club member is flying without the card, please call the ranger and they will handle the situation.
