## UPDATE: WIRELESS BUDDY BOX - by Roger McClurg

I finally got a receiver to use for my wireless buddy box. It's a Hobby King Orange R615X. It is a 6 channel receiver that outputs CPPM on the battery/bind pins.



I made a cable to connect the receiver and the transmitter from an old servo cable and a one end of a 3.5mm mono audio cable. I removed the center wire (positive lead) from the servo cable, and soldered the signal wire to the tip wire and the black wire (negative lead) to the sleeve wire. The whole process took 10 minutes.

I bound the receiver to my JR9303 transmitter (any DSM2 or DSMX transmitter will work), and I was ready to go. My Taranis transmitter has an empty module bay, so I put the receiver and battery there. You can just as easily attach them to the



back of your transmitter with some Velcro. Turn on the student transmitter, plug the battery into the receiver, and then plug in the audio cable into the instructor transmitter, and you are ready to go.
